

## Fire Protection Inspector

Provides fire inspection services within assigned area of responsibility. Inspects fire protection devices, systems and procedures to ensure proper operation and compliance with applicable standards and requirements. Plans, schedules, and conducts training programs for all functional areas of the Fire/Security Section. Maintains training reference files, directives, office instructions, lesson plans, training aids, and training records. Responds to emergencies, evaluates operational procedures, acts as safety officer, assists with rescue, fire suppression and overhaul when directed. May function as a firefighter to supplement existing personnel when required. As directed by management, may supervise employees or subcontractor personnel in accordance with the "General Supervisory Duties and Responsibilities" addendum.

## **Basic requirements**

- High school diploma / GED equivalent, or an equivalent combination of education and experience, and a minimum of 5 years related experience.
- Requires the job knowledge, skill level and physical ability necessary to perform assigned job functions.
- Must be a U.S. Citizen.
- Must have a Secret Security Clearance
- The Fire Protection Inspector is a multi-site resource traveling between sites to perform inspections, reviews, and training.
- Must be NICET Level II certified.
- Position may be located in a wide variety of environments, from conventional indoor office workspace to project worksites with harsh, working and living conditions.
- To ensure compliance with safety, health and security requirements in the contract, employee will possess
  the ability to read, write, speak, and understand the English language at the intermediate level as
  necessary to perform assigned job functions.
- Position requires the basic skills and physical ability necessary to perform assigned job functions.
- Prior military and/or contingency experience is a plus.
